Offered by

The late Margaret Carroll was a distinguished member of the Board of Directors of Union Hospital serving from 1941 until 1989, at which time she was elected an Emeritus member of the Board of Directors. She was also a long time advisor to the Service League of Union Hospital. As a member of the Board of Directors, Margaret Carroll provided counsel and leadership to guide Union Hospital's service to Terre Haute and the Wabash Valley. During her service as a member of the board, the hospital sustained and built upon its reputation for providing advanced medical care to residents of the Wabash Valley.

This scholarship was named for Margaret Carroll as a tribute to her dedicated service to Union Hospital and the Service League. **Eligibility**

To be eligible for a Margaret Carroll Scholarship an applicant must:

- Be children of full-time or part-time A employees of Union Hospital Health System
- Be enrolled for the 2012-2013 academic year in a full-time undergraduate program at Indiana State University, Rose-Hulman Institute of Technology, Saint Mary-of-the-Woods College, Ivy Tech Community College, or any of the state-supported universities in Indiana (Indiana University, Purdue University, Ball State University, Vincennes University, or the University of Southern Indiana).
- Have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or better.
- Demonstrate financial need.

**Requirements of Scholarship Recipients**

A recipient of a Margaret Carroll Academic Scholarship must:

- Maintain the status of a full-time student, minimum of 12 credit hours per semester or the equivalent
- Maintain a minimum cumulative grade point average of at least a 3.0 on a 4.0 scale or the equivalent
